

QuickMap February 2010 Upgrade

To install the **February 10** update (**V7.3.147**), insert the disk into your CD-ROM and run **Setup.exe**.

Verified Data

We decided we need to promote one of QuickMap's main features a lot better, so from now on, wherever you see QuickMap, you will usually see our **Verified Data** stamp.



We want to draw attention to the fact we have NZ's most comprehensive link between different datasets (e.g. LINZ Parcel, Title/Owner, REINZ historic sales, Rateable Value etc). This match helps you find data you could easily miss, and allows us to identify and correct many errors.

We realise it is impossible to make the data error-free, but we strive to remain NZ's most reliable source of property information by running data verification processes unique to QuickMap.

High Quality Topographical Maps are now available for QuickMap. These new topo maps are derived from the new 1:50,000 and 1:250,000 NZTM raster sheets released from LINZ in September 2009. They come on 3 disks per Island, and are available for **\$100+GST** per Island.

House Finder is free to QuickMap® **SalesView** subscribers and provides detailed descriptions and photos on properties advertised for sale. With over 300,000 listings, it's easily the most comprehensive database of listed current **and historic** properties on the market. It's a lot easier to compare properties when you can actually see inside the house!

You may have noticed that Google Earth has made some changes which has affected the link between QuickMap and **StreetView**. A fix for this is included in this version.

Recently added features also include:

- Support for NZTM ecw files. Adding NZTM images to QuickMap is now easy. Just drag/drop the files into QuickMap. If the images are in NZTM format, QuickMap will re-project them on the fly.
- Support for JPEG2000 (jp2) files. Just drag/drop them into QuickMap. The great thing about JPEG2000 is that it supports transparency; but be warned - they are a little slower to draw than ecw files.
- Ability to export points in dxf format. This allows Geodetic marks and other point features to be imported into applications such as 12D.
- Updated Schools data and the ability to include schools in the QuickMap® SalesView Market Appraisal.
- NZTM grid layer.
- Allow point and line text size to be scaled up, down or WYSIWYG (What you see is what you get) when printing. This feature is accessed through the Symbology Editor Points Label Form.
